Be aware that use of a terrain park requires greater skiing or boarding skills and recognize that there are bumps, ridges, spines and other features present that are unique to a terrain park.

A season passholder should be familiar with the "Skiers Responsibility Code" and responsibilities under State law (ORC 4169.08C).

A Platinum pass is TRANSFERABLE; if lost or stolen it is not replaceable. All Season Passes, except Platinum, are NOT TRANSFERABLE; and in the event that a season pass is lost, stolen, broken or unrecognizable, a fee must be paid for a replacement ID. Notify Snow Trails immediately of a missing
